Resolutions adopted at the General Body meeting held on 1st May 2011

The General Body demands the Central Government to immediately consider and implement the following matters to the welfare of Backward Classes.

- 1. To constitute a Parliamentary Committee for OBC.
- Constitutional Powers to National Commission for Backward Classes.
- 3. To conduct caste wise enumeration in Census 2011 based on socio economic criteria.
- 4. To implement the Mandal Recommendations relating to
 - · Reservation in Promotion
 - · Reservation in Judiciary
 - · Reservation in Private Sector
- Certain Relaxations / Concessions viz,
 Pre-Recruitment Training to OBC candidates appearing in the Examination conducted by Govt. and Public Sector undertakings including Banks:

- Concession in Examination Fee.
- Pre- Promotion Training to OBC employees appearing for the departmental promotion Test.
- OBC member in the interview / selection committee.

The General Body demands the Union Bank of India management to consider the following:

To assess the man power requirement of the branches of Union Bank of India in Uttar Pradesh & Uttrakhand and to make proposal for new recruitment in Sub-Staff, Clerical & Officer Cadre.
