Minutes of the meeting



AGRA/15 Jan 23/ Hotel Indian by choice: Today Agra Unit of Union Bank Backward Classes (OBC) Employees Welfare Association, UP has conducted its first ever members meet under the leadership of Mr. Ajay Kumar and other team members. Agenda of the meeting was:

- to interact with members
- to discuss on several issues related to OBC, such as scenario of OBC employees in PSUs after implementation of Mandal Commission.
- Role of our AIOBC Federation & G.Karunanidhy and our team in bringing Education Bill in the Lok Sabha on 13 Dec 2006, which was passed by the Lower House providing 27% reservation in IIT, IIM, AIIMS and other educational education. Later on Mr. Shiv Khera file a writ petition in the honorable Supreme Court of India against this Education Bill. A constitutional Bench approved this Education Bill in 2008.
- Role of AIOBC Federation in pursuing honorable MPs to constitute a Parliamentary Committee for OBC. The undersigned followed regularly to Shri G. Karunanidhy and visited New Delhi several times during sessions and meet honorable MPs at their Delhi's residences with letters containing the contents of the need to constitute a Parliamentary Committee for OBC, As there were no official authoritative Body to examine implementation of 27% reservation in different PSUs and other Govt Sectors.

- Association has been making regular follow up with the Union Bank Management to provide Orientation Training Programme to OBC employees since 1998. As of now Bank management is providing 5 days OTP to OBC employees of Union Bank at every level of promotion where fast track written examination is conducted. Association conveys its gratitude to the management for favorable consideration of our demands for OTP.
- ♦ 3 days workshop on reservation management is being conducted by the management for Association Representatives at different Staff Training Centres/ College every year which focus in detail methods of maintaining roaster in direct recruitment in PSUs & Govt Sectors.
- ♦ Bank has imparted training workshop for 3 days on defence procedures at certain interval of time, which is highly useful for the representatives of the Association.
- ◆ AIOBC Federation plays a key role to restore 27% reservation in UG & PG medical admission in central quota. During last 3 years (2019,2020 & 2021) no reservation was given by the Central Universities on 15% transferred seat form different state. We are thankful to Shri G. Karunanidhy for taking immediate steps, his repeated Twits, his letters to almost 20 Chief Ministers regarding ZERO reservation in medical UG & PG quota. It has a long story of struggles, court cases then finally verdict came from SC in 2021 and Govt of India had to implement 27% reservation in PG/UG admission at Central University level in 15% transferred seat. Hats off to Sri G. Karunanidhy.





Deliberation from members:

Ajay Kumar, Secretary of Agra Unit, started the meeting with his welcome speech. He presented a brief note on the agenda of meeting and requested the members present in the meeting hall to share his/her views. Saurabh Katiyar told that since the inception of the Unit at Agra, it was much expected to have a meeting with the State Representatives. We are very happy to have this meeting today. Raj Kumar Baghel told that it was encouraging moment for us, we will try our level best to continue this tempo and energy in future also. **Dhirendra Sharma** told that he was a member of the association since 2013. He was waiting for the meeting since long. Pallavi Kushwaha told that she had attended Orientation Training Programme before her promotion. It was for 5 days and it is highly beneficial for our people. To stay at Hotel with special leave undergo the training system is really a good support for us. For all these achievements Association pay their respect and regards to **Shri G. Karunidhy** on behalf of thousands medical students.

UP State Body has conducted a huge Felicitation Function for successful UPSC candidates belong to SC/ST & OBC in year **2010,2011 & 2012** keeping in view that these **new bureaucrats** will work for social inequalities in there are of work. General Secretary briefed a detail journey of Orientation Training Programme, provided to OBC employees in Union Bank of India. Union Bank of India is pioneer among all nationalized banks in India.
